Capital Hill Historic, Seattle



CAPITAL HILL HISTORIC – Detailing and craftsmanship highlight this historic home. A new deck with built-in benches and stone inlay provide space for relaxing. Stacked stone retaining walls offer an aesthetic solution to the site's grading challenges. Concrete stairs with slate detailing create a warm entrance and blend into the surrounding plantings and architecture. Wood arbors, accent lighting, and a natural water feature complete the picture.



Windermere Traditional, Seattle



WINDERMERE TRADITIONAL – As part of a major remodel for this classic NW contemporary home, the landscape was expanded, redesigned and enhanced for entertaining. Stamped concrete patios, connected by a series of stepping stone pavers, provide usable areas surrounded by lush plantings and stucco privacy walls. The rear garden also includes a private arbor swing where the users of this space can take in the vibrant garden view.



Urban Chic, Bellevue



URBAN CHIC – Just blocks from downtown Bellevue, this home blends relaxation with an active outdoor lifestyle. The gardens include stacked stone retaining walls, pavers, and plantings that blend with the home's unique color pattern. The low-maintenance rear gardens provide space for entertaining dinner guests, fun on the custom putting green and cozy evenings around a gas fire pit.



Mid-Century Oasis, Seattle



MID-CENTURY OASIS – The gardens for this traditional rambler style home were bland, exposed, and provided no usable space for the new residents. Our design utilized curved walkways to create a formal entrance and plantings to provide privacy for the rear patio area. The focal point of this design is a natural stone water feature that provides a peaceful and picturesque backdrop from the kitchen window.
